 - v. School Musical/Play intermission concession: February 3 and 4: coffee, hot chocolate, cookies. *Will finalize plans at January meeting.*
- b. Sports Equipment: \$3500 requested- Motion approved with stipulation of “when funds available” (following movie night).
- c. CSCC Newsletter/Introductions/Transparency: Ashley proposing a biannual CSCC update/newsletter. The first one in February to include a group photo introducing the team. Include progress of fundraisers so far this year, where the funds are going, and future plans. *****Plan for group photo on the presentation stairs at the January meeting*****
