The Square Reader

Pros:

Credit and debit card

Secure

Long battery life

Accepts chips, PIN, contactless, Apple and Google Pay

Cons: must have Wi-Fi

Card must be present

Cost: \$69

Fees:

In person - The cost to you is 2.5% per transaction when a customer taps or inserts a credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and international credit card) or 0.75% + 7¢ per Interac debit transaction

Card-not-present – when you manually key in card details or use a card on file it is 3.3% +15 cents (only applies to the full terminal. To use the square the card must be present)

When the customer makes a purchase online it is a 2.8% +30 cents
